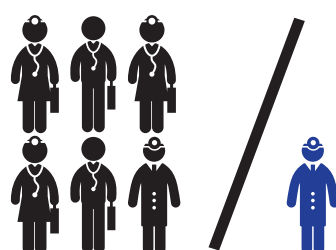


# 10 FAST FACTS

## ABOUT RESIDENT DOCTORS IN CANADA

### 6 to 1

For every 6 active physicians in Canada, there is 1 resident.



### Paying it Forward

After completing their training, over 80% of residents plan to spend time in teaching/education roles.

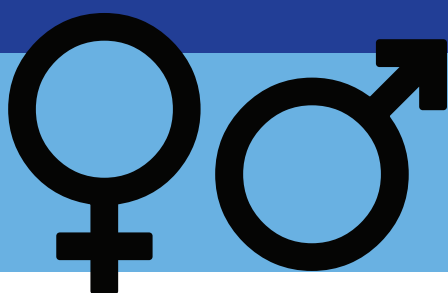


### Demographically Speaking

Over 70% of residents were born in Canada, with the other 30% coming from over 45 countries.

### Fine Fellows

Almost 2,500 residents further their training through fellowships.



### Gender Mix

There are slightly more women than men in residency.

### Beyond the Teaching Hospital

Residents provide care throughout Canada in a variety of urban, rural, and remote communities.

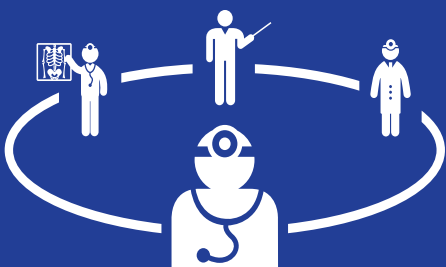


### Just My Specialty

Residents train in one of over 80 specialties. In 2015, Family Medicine was the most preferred choice followed by Internal Medicine and all surgical disciplines.

### Home Sweet Home

75% of Canadian residents who completed their training in 2009 were practicing medicine in the same province five years later.

As an integral part of the frontline of patient-centered healthcare, resident doctors are teachers, trainees, and clinicians.

### 30-something

The average age of resident doctors in Canada is just over 30.
